
The scouts were taught simple aerodynamics by assembling a foam glider, and flying it.






Eric Armstrong, Vic Lerum, Mark Olson, Chuck Riley, Joe Villarreal.






Don White informed us that the 2025 Heli Fun Fly will be held at our field in February. It will be earlier than usual because of the unknown ending date of our field.




