Pilots from everywhere! Food catering. Pilot raffels, great flying! This is our biggest event of the year! Come on out and be amazed! Night flying!















John was 95 years old when he attended our club meeting on Jan, 18! Happy Birthday to you! You are in excellent shape! Wow!


